It has recently been turned into a superb restaurant with good service and excellent views over the village and the Montsant mountain range. They offer weekday menus for 12 Euros and weekend menus for 18 Euros. Great value for money. Two rooms, one for smokers and one for non-smokers. Seats around 40 people. Well worth a visit.
